

Lint accumulation is the most common dryer problem homeowners face, and it triggers a critical choice: repair or replace. Should You Repair or Replace a Dryer When Buildup Causes Problems?

Lint is the leading dryer failure cause because it's unavoidable. Every load sheds fibers that the filter catches, but lint also builds up inside the drum seal, around the blower wheel, and deep in the exhaust vent. Over time, trapped lint restricts airflow, forces the heating element to work harder, and can ignite if temperatures spike. How the 50 Percent Rule Guides Your Repair-or-Replace Decision

The 50 percent rule is straightforward: if a repair costs more than half the price of a new dryer, replace the unit. A new dryer costs between \$400 and \$800 for a standard electric model. If Urgent Appliance Repair Sacramento diagnoses a lint-clogged vent requiring \$200 to clean and restore airflow, that repair represents 25 to 50 percent of replacement cost, making repair the smart choice. If the same dryer also needs a new thermal fuse, blower wheel, and vent rework—pushing the total to \$450—you've crossed the 50 percent threshold, and a new dryer becomes the better investment. The filter catches surface lint, but lint works its way into the blower housing, around the drum felt seal, and through the exhaust vent to the outdoor termination. A homeowner vacuuming the filter slot helps, but it doesn't reach the buildup that causes real [local appliance service near me](#) problems. Once cleared, airflow restores, drying time normalizes, and fire risk drops dramatically. Lint buildup can damage the dryer's internal components, especially the thermal fuse and blower wheel. The thermal fuse is a one-time safety device that blows if the dryer overheats—often from restricted airflow caused

by lint. When it fails, the dryer won't start, and the fuse must be replaced. Similarly, lint accumulation can jam the blower wheel, preventing it from moving air and forcing the motor to work harder until it wears out prematurely. If our technician diagnoses a blown fuse or damaged blower wheel alongside the lint problem, the total repair cost may climb to \$350 or higher. At that point, the 50 percent rule guides you toward replacement. The distinction matters: a straightforward cleaning is a clear repair win, but compound damage from extended lint exposure tips the scale toward replacement.

Dryer Age and the Repair-Replace Calculation

A dryer's age influences the repair-or-replace math significantly. A 4-year-old dryer with a lint problem and a blown thermal fuse makes sense to repair because you have many years of service remaining. 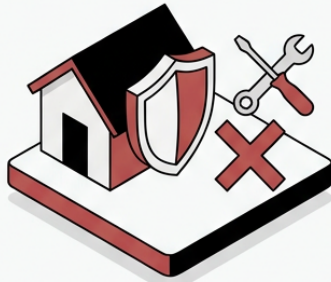
