2. The Steam Community Market

For specific cases-- especially older ones or those tied to specific operations-- gamers must turn to the Steam Community Market or third-party trading sites. Prices fluctuate based on supply, need, and general gamer counts.

The Mathematics of CS2 Cases: Odds and Rarities

Before opening a CS2 case, every player should understand the odds. Valve officially discloses drop rates for Chinese markets due to regulatory compliance, and those rates apply internationally.

Item Rarity Tier Approximate Drop Rate Visual Indicator **Consumer Grade** (Mil-Spec) ~ 79.92% Blue **Industrial Grade** (Restricted) ~ 15.98% Purple **Mil-Spec** (Classified) ~ 3.20% Pink **Restricted** (Covert) ~ 0.64% Red **Unique** (Special Item/ Knife/ Gloves) ~ 0.26% Gold

Keep in mind: StatTrak™ versions, which track the variety of kills made with a weapon, have a separate 10% opportunity to replace a standard-tier weapon of any rarity.

Statistically speaking, opening CS2 cases is a losing financial proposal. Since the odds of unpacking a high-tier covert skin or a rare knife are fractions of a percent, the expected return on financial investment (ROI) per case opened is traditionally well below the £ 2.50 expense of a key.

The presence of cases has actually birthed a huge secondary economy. This produces a basic choice for gamers desiring new skins: **Should you open cases or buy skins directly?**

Advantages and disadvantages of Opening Cases

- **Pros:**
