The Anatomy of the Wheel

The Top Slot: Enhancing Every Spin

Before the main wheel is spun, a secondary two-reel fruit machine positioned directly above the wheel spins at the same time.

1. **Reel 1** displays among the wagering sections (numbers or bonus offer games).
2. **Reel 2** display screens a multiplier value (varying from 2x to 50x).

If the sign on the very first reel aligns horizontally with the multiplier on the 2nd reel, that multiplier is applied to the sector for that spin. If the wheel arrive on a winning number or bonus offer game that has been picked by the Top Slot, payouts or bonus round multipliers are significantly increased.



The Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The primary attraction of the game is its four bonus offer rounds. These mini-games transport gamers far from the main wheel into immersive, digitally enhanced reward arenas.

- **1. Coin Flip**
 - **How it works:** A basic red and blue coin is turned by the presenter (or a mechanical arm). Each side of the coin is assigned a random multiplier before the flip. Whichever side lands face up wins that multiplier for the participating gamers.
- **2. Cash Hunt**
 - **How it works:** Players are presented with an enormous screen showing 105 random multipliers concealed behind shooting gallery targets (symbols like a cactus, target, hat, and so on). Utilizing a virtual cannon, players aim and shoot at one target before the timer goes out, revealing their private multiplier.
- **3. Pachinko**
 - **How it works:** Inspired by the traditional Japanese arcade video game, players view as the host drops a puck down a board filled with pegs. The puck bounces its method to the bottom, landing in one of several multiplier slots-- or potentially a "DOUBLE" slot, which doubles all multipliers on the board and activates a re-drop.
- **4. Crazy Time (The Grand Finale)**
 - **How it works:** Players enter a virtual world behind a red door, facing a huge, custom wheel with 64 sectors. Players should pick one of 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is awarded. This round features "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" sectors, allowing multipliers to climb to a staggering 20,000 x.

Key Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is basically a game of chance powered by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, gamers typically use different bankroll management techniques to optimize their playtime and satisfaction.

- **The Conservative Number Strategy:**
 - Focusing bets mostly on the numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) while placing small backup bets on the reward rounds. Because the numbers 1 and 2 comprise over half the wheel, this technique yields frequent, smaller wins that sustain a bankroll.
- **The Bonus-Hunter Strategy:**
 - Placing wagers specifically on the four reward round sectors (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This technique accepts that base game number hits will yield no return, intending instead to strike the high-paying bonus offer rounds where the enormous multipliers live.
- **The Spread-The-Risk Approach:**
 - Betting little amounts across nearly every section on the board. This guarantees that the gamer enters nearly every reward round or hits regular number payouts, though it needs careful management to guarantee wins surpass the total expense of the bets.
