- **Straight:** Three consecutive-rank cards.
- **3 of a Kind:** Three cards of the exact same rank.
- **Straight Flush:** Three successive cards of the exact same fit.
- **Fit Trips:** Three similar cards (very same rank and match).

3. Bet Behind

While technically a function rather than a card-based side bet, **Bet Behind** allows gamers who are waiting on an empty seat at a live table to bet on the hand of a seated player. 21 +3 (Suited Trips)	Three identical cards	100:1 ~ 3.70%	

(Note: House edges can vary somewhat depending [live blackjack](#) upon the particular number of card decks utilized in the shoe-- normally between 6 and 8 decks in live blackjack).
