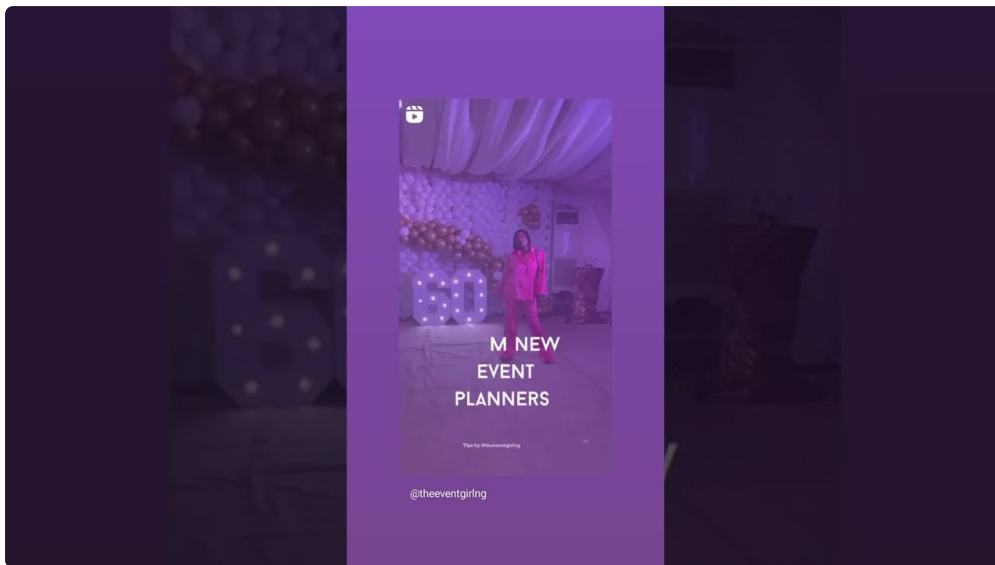


Handmade Decor While Hiring a Planner for Event Management

If you're interested in personalizing your aesthetic elements, particular elements are easier than others. Fabric bunting are all excellent choices for self-making.

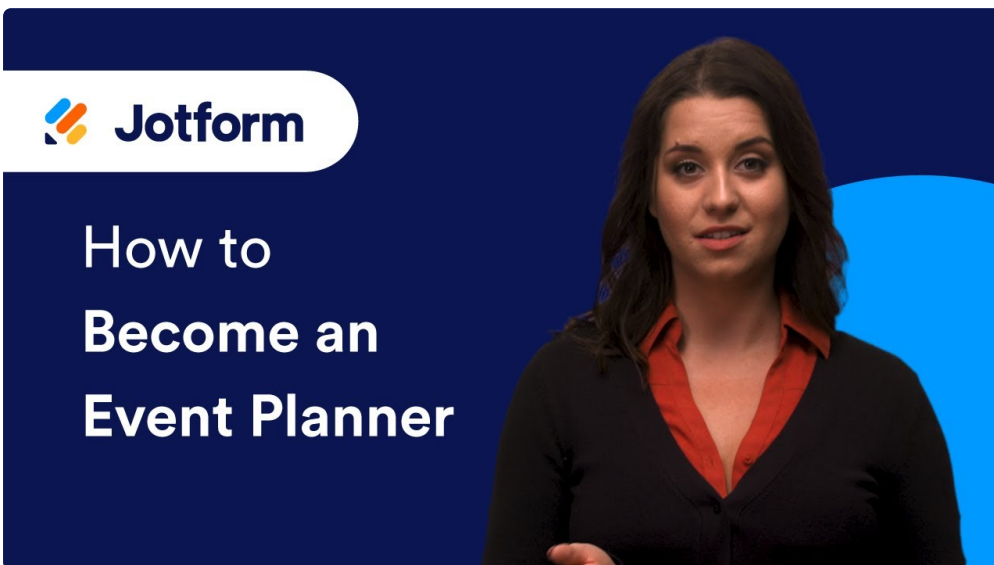


Evaluate your expertise when choosing which projects to take on. If you're not crafty with crafting, stick with simpler projects that are harder to mess up.
