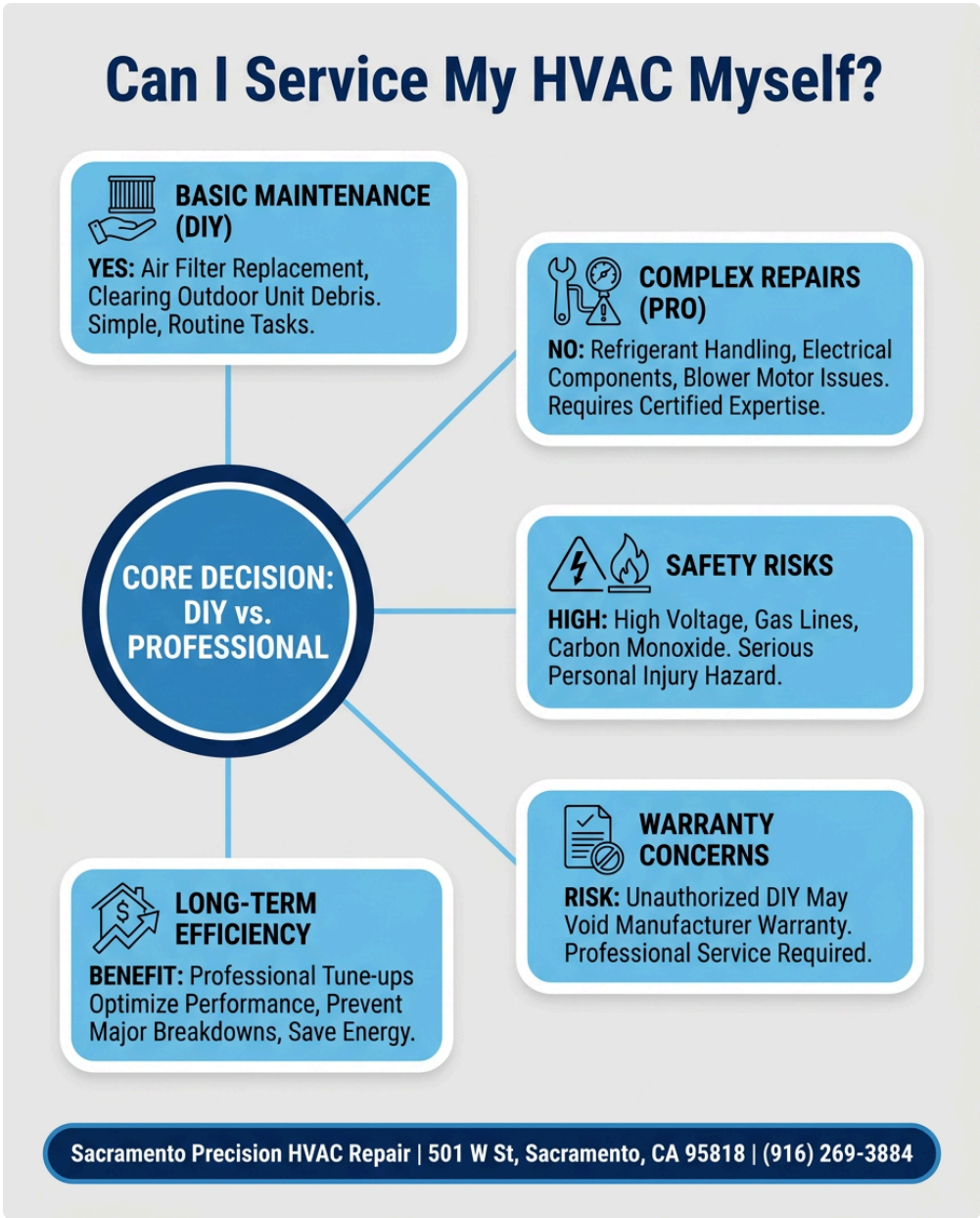

What Happens During an Emergency HVAC Repair Diagnosis?
