1. Keep Flash Paper dry and stored flat, far from pockets and the rest which may crease it.
2. Handle it with clear, dry arms and avoid oils. If you touch it, don't smudge the surface you plan to ignite.
3. Stage the ignition level so you are not attaining awkwardly across your own frame, the target audience should still see the moment, no longer your scramble.
4. Use a lighting fixtures system you can actually manage easily and properly every time. If it's fiddly throughout the time of practice session, this will fail beneath power.

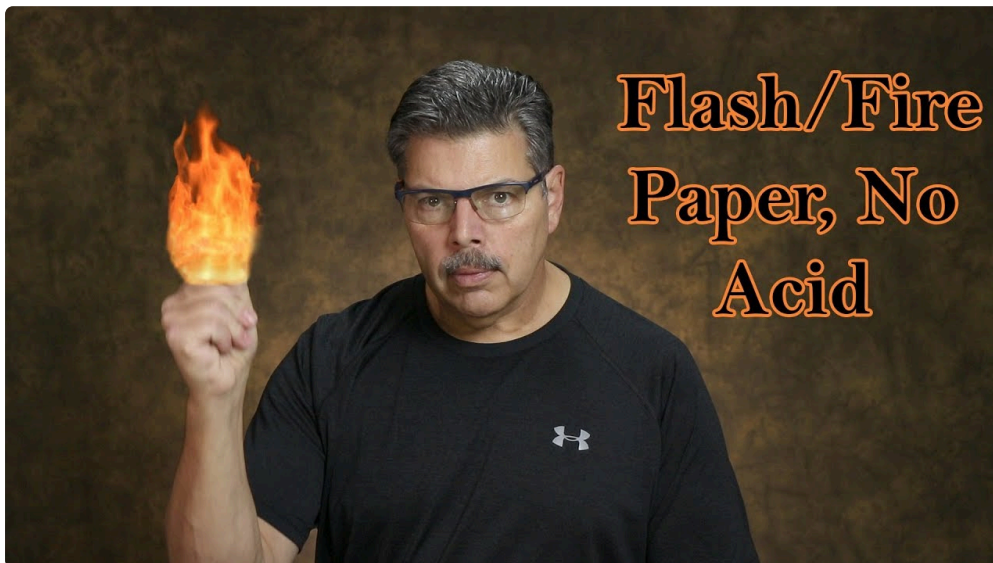
