The Top Slot Feature: Amplifying the Action

Before every single spin of the main wheel, a secondary, two-reel slots spins at the same time above the main game. This is referred to as the **Top Slot**.

- **Reel 1** displays a segment of the wheel (either a number or a bonus game).
- **Reel 2** screens a multiplier (ranging from 2x up to 50x).

If the symbol on the first reel lines up horizontally with the multiplier on the second reel, that multiplier is used to the matching section for that round. If the wheel lands on that specific segment, all wins for that outcome are multiplied. This function is where the capacity for enormous payouts stems.

Diving Into the Four Bonus Rounds

The true heart of Crazy Time lies in its four perk rounds. Landing on among these sections carries gamers out of the base video game and into a totally different, highly interactive environment.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest and most regular bonus offer round. A coin with a red side and a blue side is turned by a mechanical flipper.

- Before the flip, random multipliers are appointed to both the red and blue sides.
- Whichever side lands deal with up awards the gamer the multiplier connected to it.

2. Money Hunt

This bonus transforms the screen into a huge shooting gallery featuring a 108-multiplier grid.

- The multipliers are arbitrarily shuffled and hidden behind numerous signs (such as a cactus, target, or chef's hat).
- Gamers are offered a minimal countdown timer to goal and fire a cannon at the sign of their choice, exposing the covert multiplier below. Due to the fact that each gamer selects their own target, private outcomes will differ.

3. Pachinko

Influenced by the standard Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko features a radiant, vertical board filled with physical pegs.

- The speaker drops a puck from the top of the board.
- As the puck bounces randomly down through the pegs, it ultimately lands at the bottom in among several multiplier zones-- or on a "DOUBLE" slot, which doubles all multipliers on the board and triggers a drop-again.

4. Crazy Time

The holy grail of the video game. Hitting this single sector on the primary wheel opens a door to a jaw-dropping virtual world behind the studio wall.

- Gamers are greeted by a massive, 64-segment virtual wheel including 3 flippers (Blue, Green, and Yellow).
- Gamers need to choose among the three flippers before the wheel spins.
- The wheel can reach incredible heights, providing multipliers up to 20,000 x if "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" sectors are hit along the method.

Popular Approaches and Play Styles

While Crazy Time is essentially a game of chance determined by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, players frequently embrace particular methods to handle their bankroll and maximize their time of entertainment.

- **The Low-Volatility Strategy (Conservative):**
 - Focuses greatly on the number sections (1, 2, and 5) to secure frequent, smaller sized wins.

- Often includes little coverage bets on the bonus rounds just in case they hit.
- *Objective:* Prolong gameplay and reduce rapid bankroll depletion.
- **The Bonus-Hunter Strategy (High Risk):**
 - Ignores the numerical sectors totally or puts minimal bets on them.
 - Allocates funds specifically to the 4 perk rounds (*Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time*).
 - *Goal:* Position oneself to get in the high-paying mini-games, accepting that dry spells between perks prevail.
- **The Balanced Approach:**
 - Spreads bets uniformly throughout a mix of numbers and bonus functions to maintain a consistent balance while keeping the door open for big feature hits.
