

A burnt outlet represents a documented failure against established inspection standards and represents an emergency condition requiring immediate professional evaluation. When an outlet shows burn marks, discoloration, or charring, it has failed the fundamental compliance benchmark for safe electrical conductivity and must be inspected and repaired by a licensed electrician before further use.

What Do Pass-Fail Standards Require When Outlets Show Burn Marks?

All three scenarios represent active fire hazards under code inspection standards.
