4. **Adaptive Mid-Round Calls**-- The new audio engine permits faster call-outs; squads that change on the fly (e.g., shifting from a default perform to a quick split) can capture opponents off-guard.
5. **Post-Plant Positioning**-- With smoke responding to bullets, protectors can now block sightlines after planting the bomb, turning a basic hold into a dynamic battle of geometry.
