A Factory New Souvenir Dragon Lore signed by superstar player Skadoodle notoriously cost over £ 60,000 years back, and costs have actually only intensified because.

2. The AK-47|Case Hardened (Pattern 661 "Blue Gem")

While a basic Case Hardened AK-47 is fairly affordable, the top-tier pattern indices-- particularly Pattern 661-- cover nearly the whole leading receiver of the gun in a beautiful, reflective blue.
