4. COMPLETE UNIT OVERHAUL OR REPLACEMENT

Necessitates full system replacement, often including new installation and permits.

A repair makes sense when the cost is less than 30 to 40 percent of a new system's price and your unit still has five or more years of expected life ahead. If your compressor fails at year 12, a \$1,500 to \$2,500 repair might be

worth it, especially if you've had minimal prior service calls. Conversely, if your system is 18 years old and has already needed two repairs in the last year, the next failure is likely around the corner—and replacement saves money long term.
