A roof lives longer when it remains dry and near the out of doors temperature. That is the purpose. The two tools we have now are airflow and thermal resistance. Airflow, the ventilation edge, strips away moisture and heat that could or else linger at the bottom of the roof deck. Thermal resistance, the insulation side, slows warmness escaping from the home into the attic in winter, and blocks warmness pushing down into the living area in summer time.

Where many Glastonbury householders get in drawback is blending the 2 devoid of sealing the air leaks that attach the condominium to the attic. Warm, humid air that escapes as a result of can lighting over a kitchen on Main Street will to find the bloodless roof deck in January, condense, and set the table for mold. Insulation that performs in proper houses

Loose fill cellulose provides a dense, effectively dispensed blanket across attic flooring in older Glastonbury homes with irregular framing.
