3. Diversify Your Case Selection

Prevent discarding your entire budget plan into a single high-tier case like *Operation Bravo* or *Recoil*. Rather, mix low-tier, stable-return cases with a couple of high-variance cases to stabilize the threat.

4. Utilize "Crazy Mode" Cautiously

Crazy Mode (where the most affordable total worth wins) turns basic logic on its head. While it can be enjoyable, it relies completely on hitting low-cost, low-tier drops. Do not approach this mode with standard case-opening logic.
