- A number of these websites require visiting through Steam, which can expose accounts to phishing scams or API rip-offs.
- Platforms that ask users to deposit funds or products simply to unlock a "complimentary" case are normally predatory.
- Valve actively cracks down on gaming and unauthorized trading bots, indicating users risk having their Steam inventories trade-banned.

Regularly Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. Do I require CS: GO/CS2 Prime Status to get free cases?

Yes. To be eligible for weekly case drops and product drops, your Steam account need to have Prime Status. Non-prime accounts do not get random item drops or profile XP rewards that activate the weekly care plan.

2. How lots of free cases can I get weekly?
