Why licensing and mobile service both matter

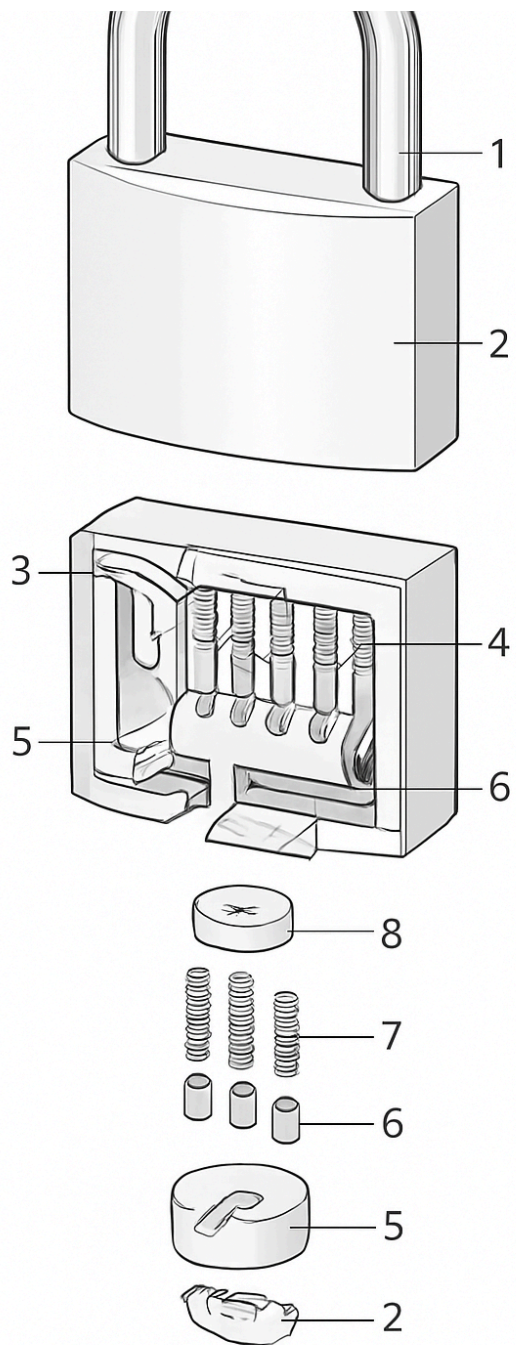
