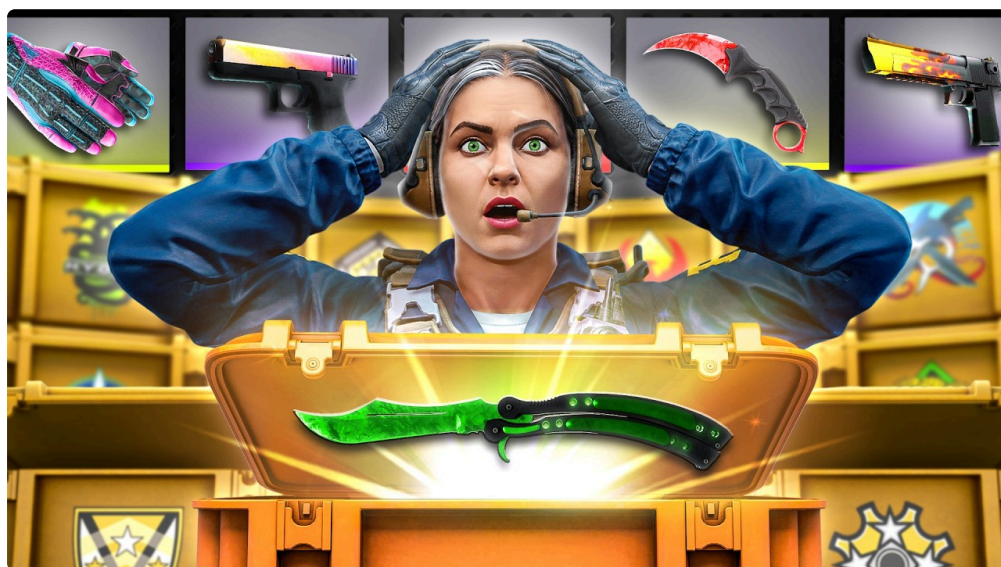

Idea: Avoid unapproved key-reselling platforms; they may break Steam's Terms of Service and lead to account charges.

- **Focus on "sticker" cases**-- Some cheap cases consist of important stickers (e.g., Cologne 2015). Sticker labels can in some cases surpass the case cost.
