- Double-sided tape or transparent tape
- A pen or marker (for elective alignment marks)
- A willing gimmick strip you'll make beforehand acting (steps under)

Let's make the gimmick.

## Build the prop: your "restorable" paper strip

Choose a paper shade that looks smart beneath room lighting. White or brilliant colours work properly since the lower line is clear and the recuperation pops.
