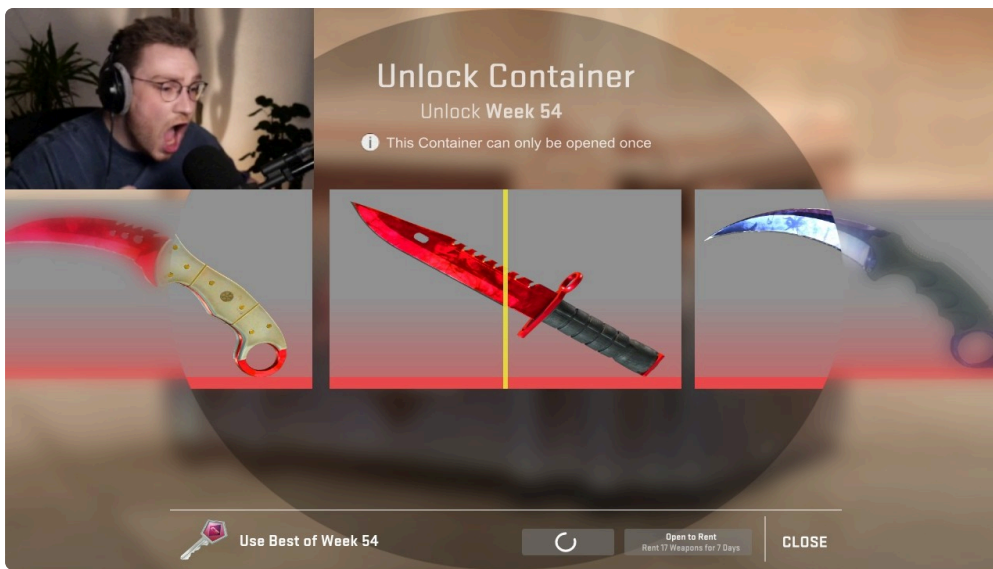

These cases are typically dismissed because of their low rate tags, however they still include a handful of desirable skins that occasionally command a premium.



Advantages and disadvantages of Going Cheap

Advantages

- **Low financial risk**-- Even a streak of "bad luck" won't greatly impact the bankroll.
