Elements That Influence Rarity

1. **Drop Rate**-- The likelihood of a case appearing as a random drop is extremely low for some older cases. For instance, the Operation Bravo Case drops are roughly 0.15% compared to 1-- 2% for contemporary cases.
2. **Occasion Duration**-- Cases tied to limited-time operations (e.g., Bravo, Shattered Web) cease to be granted once the operation ends. This produces a tough supply ceiling.
