

Most homeowners do not think much about locks until a key snaps, a deadbolt sticks, or a front door refuses to open at the worst possible moment. What mobile service changes

If the client wants multiple doors matched to a single key, the decision also depends on how those locks were originally installed.

In residential work, small problems like loose screws, weak springs, worn keys, or a rough cylinder can sometimes be corrected without changing the entire lock. A careful technician will usually explain that trade-off instead of pushing one answer for every home.

Replacement makes sense when the lock has reached the point where repairs are no longer efficient or secure enough. If the frame is soft, the strike area damaged, or the door warped, the technician may need to address more than the visible lock body.

Where electronics fit into residential work
