2. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)

- **Goal:** Ride a hot streak of 3 to 4 wins in a row, then squander and reset. This safeguards your core balance while letting your house's money ride during a streak.

3. The Low Multiplier Auto-Cashout Strategy (Conservative)

This strategy prioritizes consistency and durability over huge, life-changing payments.

- **How it works:** You set an **Auto-Cashout** at a really conservative multiplier, usually in between **1.15 x and 1.30 x**.
