Not every item should be included in an overseas shipment. Some belongings may be restricted, while others may be better transported separately or kept with you during travel.

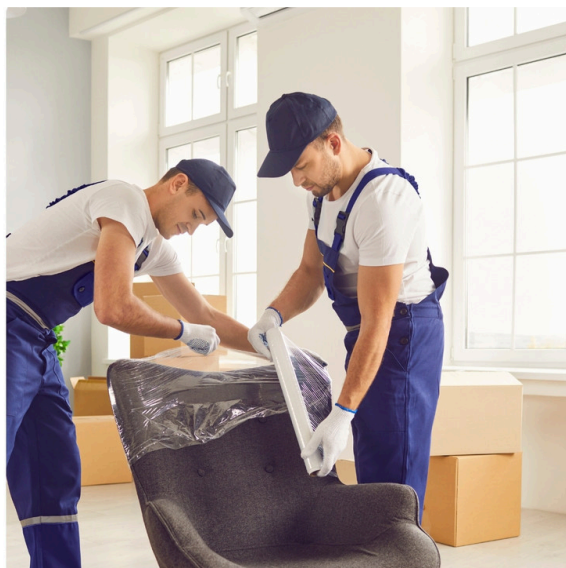
It is smart to ask what can and cannot be shipped before you start packing. That helps you avoid surprises and keeps the process more efficient.
