Consider these instances from real conversations I've carried tasks:

- Fence board spacing impacts not only personal privacy yet additionally just how wind sound journeys. Limited spacing can decrease the amount of sight with the fence, yet it can additionally alter air movement across the backyard.
- Colour and surface decisions can look different as soon as panels are mounted in real light. A color that appears excellent on a sample can appear warmer or cooler after installation, especially if the wall surface it deals with has a solid colour nearby.
