3. Prime Status Benefits

As mentioned, having Prime Status is non-negotiable for severe players wanting to make complimentary items. Prime players are matched with other Prime users (minimizing cheater encounters) and are specifically eligible for weekly care packages that consist of important weapon cases and random skin drops.

4. Significant Tournaments and View Passes

Throughout Valve-sponsored CS2 Major championships, audiences can purchase or in some cases make Souvenir Packages.

- By enjoying the competition live via the Steam TV or in-game client, or by taking part in the Pick 'Em Challenge utilizing a Viewer Pass, players can earn Souvenir Cases specific to that tournament.
- These cases do not require a crucial to open, making them 100% totally free value when acquired.

Alternative Methods: External Sites (Proceed with Caution)

Many third-party sites market "totally free CS: GO cases" through sign-up perks, discount codes, or day-to-day rewards. While a few of these platforms are genuine community-trusted trading or gambling sites, players must exercise severe care.
