On a pre-layout seek advice from, I deliver a power gauge, a notepad, and a shovel. Municipal give in Gretna more often than not affords natural static tension, yet I do now not suppose. I measure at an exterior spigot, then examine dynamic drive and drift. If the gauge presentations 70 psi static and we can keep up 10 to twelve gallons per minute using a three area inch hose devoid of losing under 45 psi, I be aware of I can group medium radius rotors at fair spacing. If drive sits curb or circulation is restricted, I plan for more zones or pressure regulated heads and nozzles that sip rather than gulp.

Soils vary across the town. In the neighborhoods north of Angus Street, I see extra loam with streaks of clay. Along newer developments close to 192nd to 204th, topsoil depth will likely be thin over compacted fill. A spade tells you right away no matter if you've gotten a forgiving profile or whatever so that it will pond at some stage in a heavy set. That impacts nozzle picks, cycle-and-soak programming, and regardless of whether we specify matched precipitation nozzles that run at zero.four to 0.6 inches consistent with hour as opposed to sprays that drown clay in ten minutes.

Sun and wind exposure are the third leg. West facing slopes near Gretna Crossing Park drink extra water than shaded part yards tucked at the back of houses on the older tree covered streets off McKenna Avenue. Spacing follows manufacturer specifications, however these are establishing issues, now not end strains. On a south dealing with slope near the Holy Family Shrine, I will cheat spacing a foot tighter to hinder overlap beneath wind. Around playsets or patios, I will shift heads to ward off damaged risers after which adjust arcs to retain policy.

## The backbone: pipe, twine, and valves

Every Gretna formula I deploy starts with a level of connection it's each protected and serviceable. We tap after the water meter with copper or PEX rated for the application, set up a complete port ball valve for isolation, then mount the backflow preventer on the precise elevation. Laterals run in 1 inch or three quarter inch depending on demand. Valve bins deserve room. Two inches of pea gravel beneath drains water and maintains dust from swallowing solenoids after a heavy storm. We label both cord in the box and on the controller, and I run a spare conductor on account that just a few cents at this time saves hours the next day to come if one line shorts. For longer cord runs throughout broad residences or industrial mowing fields near the outskirts, I specify a heavier gauge and add a surge protector at the controller. Lightning in open terrain west of city isn't theoretical.



## Smart controllers that really stay smart

Many "sensible" controllers finally end up dumb since nobody dials them in. We install controllers that improve native weather data and cycle-and-soak, then construct realistic base schedules. - At each one head, set arc and radius with the components running, then trim nozzles or switch as obligatory for factual global styles.
- Set the controller with conservative runtimes, let rain and freeze sensors, and create seasonal profiles.
