#### 1. The Weekly Care Package Drop

**Gamers need to work out severe caution.**

- Many of these sites need logging in through Steam, which can expose accounts to phishing scams or API rip-offs.
- Platforms that ask users to deposit funds or products simply to open a "free" case are typically predatory.
- Valve actively punish gambling and unauthorized trading bots, implying users run the risk of having their Steam inventories trade-banned.

Stick strictly to main Valve drop systems and the main Steam Community Market to keep accounts completely secure.

### 1. Do I require CS: GO/CS2 Prime Status to get free cases?
