The smarter approach starts with the surface itself. Older concrete may need a lower setting and more dwell time with a cleaner. Freshly poured slabs should be handled more cautiously. Pavers demand attention to joint sand and the condition of the sealant, if there is any. A driveway that has been patched or repaired often needs a blended technique so the clean finish does not highlight the repairs in a distracting way. 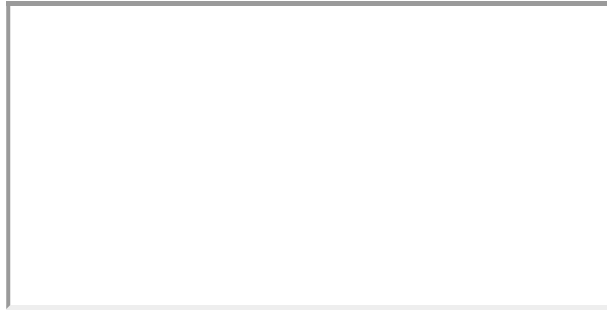
How often a driveway in Pahrump should be cleaned

There is no single schedule that fits every property. A shaded driveway with irrigation overspray may need attention more often than a wide, open slab with little traffic.
