

Hollywood, Florida has a way of surprising people who only know it as a beach town between Fort Lauderdale and Miami. Spend a day here and you start to see the layers. There is the obvious coast, of course, with the Broadwalk drawing walkers, cyclists, fishermen, and people who just want salt air and a long view of the Atlantic.
