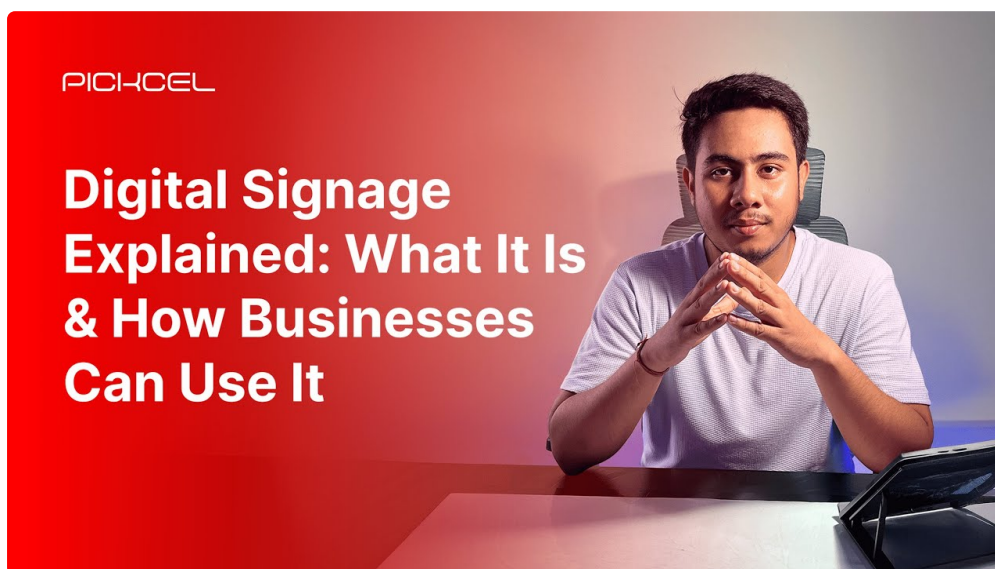

A bistro in a historic district wanted more evening walk-ins devoid of violating strict rules. Raceways have been banned, shelves discouraged. We targeted pin-fastened brushed aluminum letters at 10 inches at the painted signal band, with a delicate white 3000K wall wash less than a slim canopy. Inside, we tightened the indoor menu to a few panels, driven their terrific-promoting mussels to the top left with a cost anchor, and dimmed the menu board via 30 percent after sunset. The facade felt brighter with no gleaming. Reservations held secure, when bar stroll-ins after eight pm grew through 12 to 15 % on weekends. The inspector loved it since each and every fastener become hid, and the pals favored it when you consider that the light was hot.
