A warehouse near the river was running a 20 foot broad roll-up separating its hazmat storage space from general staging. The existing door was old enough that no one had the version number. The insurance coverage service provider flagged it, and the facility supervisor finally had cover to obtain it fixed.

We changed the setting up with a FireKing ranked rolling service door sized for the block opening. How to choose the best FireKing model

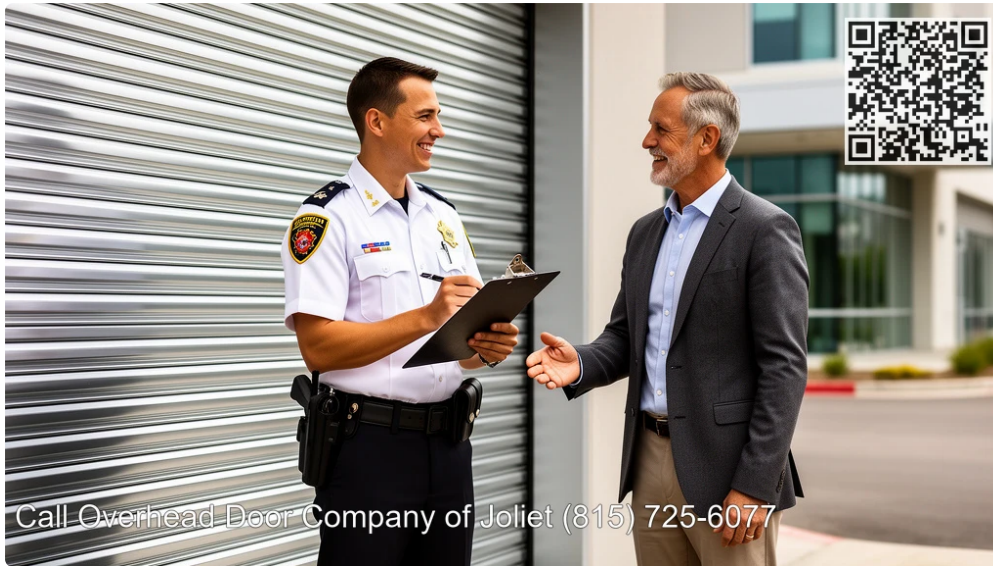

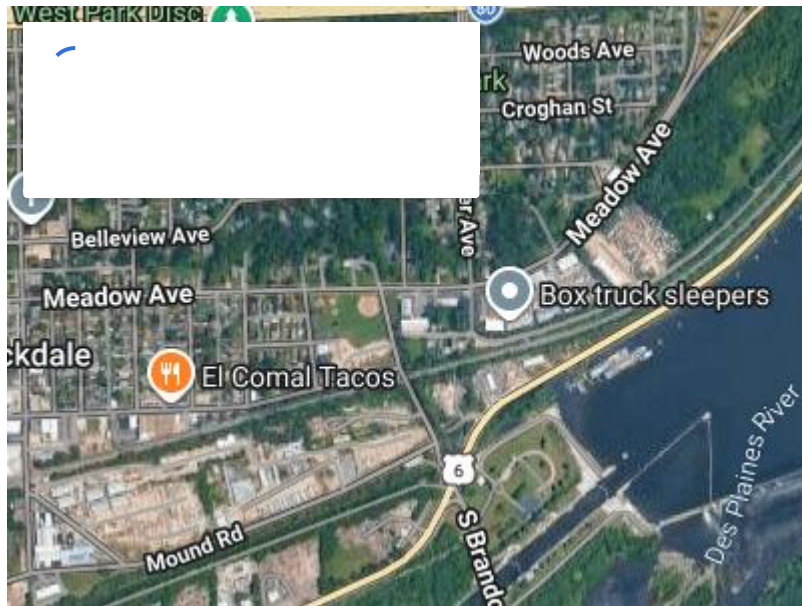
