What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live dealership video game developed around a massive, vertically installed 54-segment wheel. Hosted by an energetic, live presenter in a lively, Willy Wonka-esque studio, the video game streams in real-time to gamers around the globe.

Unlike standard table video games like blackjack or roulette, Crazy Time needs no complex memorization of guidelines or technique charts. Players simply position bets on where they think the wheel will stop, making it available to absolute novices while still offering the high volatility and enormous win capacity that seasoned gamblers yearn for.

How the Game is Played

Every video game round starts with a wagering stage. Players have a limited time to put their chips on one or more of the 8 offered betting choices on the virtual design. These alternatives consist of four numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and 4 unique benefit video games.

Once wagering closes, the live host spins the giant wheel. All at once, a separate two-reel slot positioned above the main wheel-- called the **Top Slot**-- spins along with it.

The Top Slot Mechanism

Before the wheel stops, the Top Slot generates a random multiplier and assigns it to one of the 8 betting alternatives on the wheel.

- If the Top Slot multiplier and the wheel result line up on the very same segment, the multiplier uses to that win.

- If the result is a benefit game, the multiplier increases all the multipliers *inside* that specific perk round, causing possibly astronomical payments.

Understanding the Wheel Segments and Payouts

The 54 sectors on the Crazy Time wheel are distributed amongst numbers and bonus offer games. Naturally, the lower-paying numbers appear far more frequently on the wheel than the unusual benefit rounds.

Breakdown of Wheel Segments

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times (Payout: 1:1)
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times (Payout: 2:1)
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times (Payout: 5:1)
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times (Payout: 10:1)
- **Coin Flip Bonus:** Appears 4 times
- **Money Hunt Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Pachinko Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Crazy Time Bonus:** Appears 1 time

Dive Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The real magic-- and the source of the video game's most significant payments-- lies within its 4 interactive reward rounds. Whenever the wheel arrive at a perk segment, gamers who positioned a bet on that particular feature are transported to a secondary video game screen.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the four bonuses, this round features a coin with a red side and a blue side.

- Each side is assigned a random multiplier before the flip.
- The host presses a button to flip the coin, and whichever color lands face-up awards the matching multiplier to the gamer's bet.

2. Money Hunt

This is a giant interactive shooting gallery featuring a screen with 108 random multipliers concealed behind various symbols (like a cactus, target, or chef's hat).



- Gamers utilize a virtual crosshair to intend and contend a symbol of their choice before a countdown timer expires.
- Once time goes out, all signs expose their concealed multipliers, and the gamer wins whatever value they shot.

3. Pachinko

Inspired by the conventional Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko includes a big wall filled with physical pegs.

- The host drops a puck from the top of the board.
- The puck bounces arbitrarily down the pegs till it lands in one of the slots at the bottom, which consists of a multiplier.
- If the puck lands in a **"DOUBLE"** slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for an even bigger payment.

4. Crazy Time

The crown jewel of the video game. When triggered, the host opens a red door leading into a surreal, brightly colored virtual world featuring an enormous, 64-segment mega-wheel.

- Gamers must choose one of 3 flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The host spins the wheel, and the flapper the gamer picked identifies their prize.
- This wheel features **"DOUBLE"** and **"TRIPLE"** sectors. If the flapper points to one of these, all multipliers on the wheel increase, and the wheel spins again-- enabling wins to scale approximately the video game's maximum cap of 500,000 x!

Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is eventually a game of chance dictated by RNG and physics, players frequently utilize different betting methods to handle their bankroll and maximize their time playing.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:** Betting greatly on the numbers (1 and 2) along with a little cover bet on the bonus rounds. This method yields regular, smaller wins, keeping the bankroll steady for longer periods.
- **The Bonus-Only Strategy:** Ignoring the numbers totally and putting small bets solely on the 4 benefit rounds (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This technique is high-risk, high-reward, as it depends on hitting the fairly unusual reward sections to see a return.
- **The Spread Strategy:** Placing bets across a variety of sections (numbers and bonus offers alike) to guarantee that a high portion of the wheel yields some form of return.

Vital Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a repaired entertainment budget before logging in and never ever chase losses.
- **Understand Volatility:** Bonus rounds do not struck on every spin. Anticipate droughts while waiting for a perk to set off.
- **Bet Entertainment:** Remember that live gambling establishment video games are developed mainly for fun and entertainment, not as a reputable source of income.
