A bitten cheek, tongue or lip can sometimes require urgent dental attention, particularly if bleeding is significant or the wound appears deep, and Whites Dental Marble Arch can assess these injuries. Most minor bites heal on their own, but persistent bleeding, significant swelling, or signs of infection warrant a prompt dental or medical assessment. The practice's dentists can advise on appropriate care for the injury and determine whether further treatment is needed based on the severity of the wound.

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Rinsing gently with salt water and avoiding irritating foods can help manage minor injuries while awaiting assessment if needed.
