What to Look for in a Safe Storage Facility

Climate control is the most important feature for furniture, electronics, artwork, and clothing. Non-climate-controlled units in Maryland experience significant temperature and humidity swings throughout the year. Summer heat and humidity accelerate mold growth on upholstered pieces and warp solid wood furniture over time.

Security features including surveillance cameras, gated access, and on-site management protect against theft and unauthorized entry. Confirm that the facility carries its own insurance and ask whether your homeowner's or renter's policy extends coverage to items stored off-site. - All upholstered furniture wrapped in moving blankets and sealed with stretch wrap before storage placement
- Solid wood furniture treated with appropriate coverings to prevent humidity exposure damage
- Boxes stacked by weight with heaviest items on the bottom to prevent crushing over time
- Electronics and sensitive items packed in sealed containers away from exterior unit walls
- Inventory documentation provided so every stored item is accounted for at retrieval

Packing for Long-Term Versus Short-Term Storage

Items stored for two weeks require different preparation than items stored for two months. Short-term storage prioritizes speed and accessibility. Long-term storage prioritizes protection against environmental exposure and structural stress over time.

For long-term storage, Treasure Moving Company recommends additional moisture protection for wooden furniture, individual wrapping for all upholstered pieces, and sealed plastic totes rather than cardboard boxes for clothing and linens. **rockville moving company** Cardboard absorbs humidity over time, which can lead to mold growth inside the box even in a climate-controlled environment.

Avoid Common Storage Mistakes That Lead to Damage
