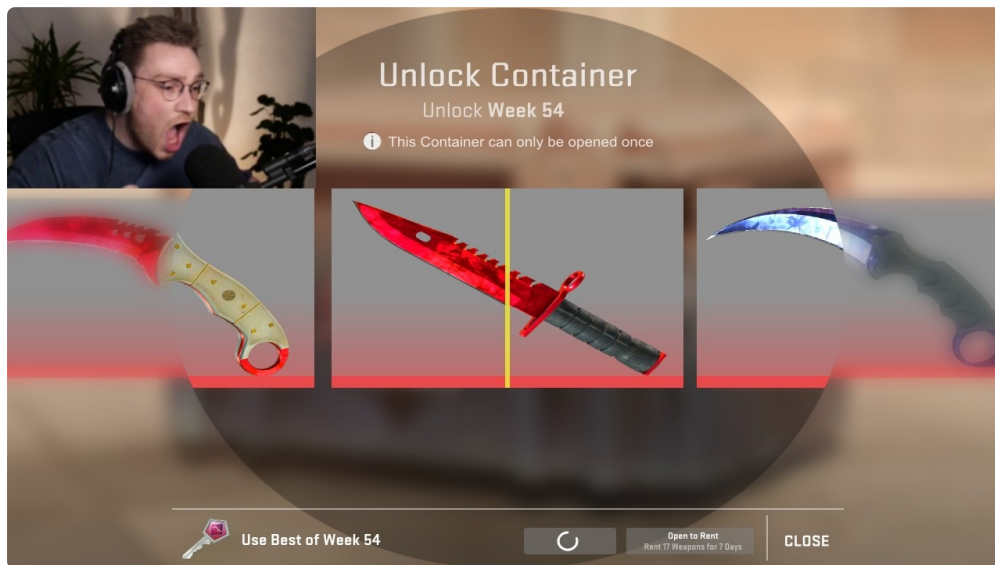
The typical distribution follows this pattern:

- **Mil-Spec products** (Blue): Approximately 79.7% opportunity
- **Restricted items** (Purple): Approximately 15.8% possibility
- **Categorized products** (Pink): Approximately 3.2% chance
- **Covert items** (Red): Approximately 0.6% opportunity
- **Rare Special Items** (Gold): Approximately 0.26% opportunity

Within each rarity tier, the specific product selection is likewise weighted. This means that some specific skins within the exact same rarity classification are more typical than others, affecting their market worth appropriately.
