2. The Martingale Strategy (Progression Betting)

- **The Strategy:** Double your bet whenever you lose, and go back to your base bet when you win.
- **The Goal:** Recover all previous losses with a single win plus a revenue equal to the base bet.

3. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)
