What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live casino video game constructed around a giant, vertical 52-segment wheel. The video game is hosted by a live, energetic speaker who spins the wheel, communicates with the audience through live chat, and guides gamers through the numerous segments.

What sets Crazy Time apart from basic wheel games (like *Dream Catcher*) is the inclusion of a leading slot placed directly above the primary wheel. With every spin, the top slot spins simultaneously, producing a random multiplier for a particular bet spot. If the wheel stops on that area and a perk or number is multiplied, gamers can win huge payouts.

Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52 sectors on the Crazy Time wheel are divided into numbers (which pay standard cash rewards) and benefit rounds (which set off minigames). Comprehending the distribution of these segments is important for managing bankrolls and understanding the game's volatility.

The Number Bets

Players can position bets on four different numbers: **1, 2, 5, and 10**. Each number represents its payment multiplier if the wheel arrive on it.

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel (highest frequency, least expensive payout of 1:1).

- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel (payout of 2:1).
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel (payment of 5:1).
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel (payout of 10:1).

The Bonus Rounds

The real excitement of Crazy Time lies in its 4 bonus offer rounds. These inhabit a combined overall of 9 sections on the wheel, making them rarer to hit, but vastly more rewarding.

1. **Coin Flip** (4 segments on the wheel)
2. **Pachinko** (2 sections on the wheel)
3. **Cash Hunt** (2 sectors on the wheel)
4. **Crazy Time** (1 segment on the wheel)

The Four Thrilling Bonus Rounds Explained

When the wheel stops on a reward segment, all gamers who placed a bet on that particular bonus offer round are transferred to a different, immersive set (or enhanced reality screen) to get involved.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the bonus rounds, Coin Flip includes a coin with a Red side and a Blue side. Each side is appointed a random multiplier by the video game system before the flip. The host pulls a lever to flip the coin, and whichever side lands deal with up awards the player that corresponding multiplier. If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can in some **crazy time game** cases be set off for a second possibility.

2. Pachinko

Motivated by the standard Japanese arcade video game, the Pachinko bonus round includes an enormous wall filled with physical pegs. The game host drops a puck from the <https://bitz.io/games/crazy-time> top of the board, and it bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs until it lands in among the multiplier zones at the bottom.

- If the puck arrive at a **"Double"** worth, all multipliers at the bottom of the wall double, and the puck is dropped once again for even higher stakes.

3. Cash Hunt

Money Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery minigame. Gamers exist with an enormous screen displaying 108 random multipliers concealed behind different signs (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).

- Players use an on-screen crosshair to aim and "shoot" their chosen symbol before the timer runs out.
- As soon as time expires, all signs reveal their concealed multipliers, and players get the multiplier attached to their selected target.

4. Crazy Time

The crown gem of the video game is the Crazy Time reward round. Players stroll through a red door into a vibrant, virtual wonderland including an enormous, 64-segment mega wheel.

- Before the wheel is spun, players need to choose among three flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow.**
- The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the selected flapper indicate is awarded to the player.

- Similar to Pachinko, this wheel includes "**Double**" and "**Triple**" segments. If the flapper arrive at among these, the multipliers on the wheel increase, and the wheel is spun once again-- potentially pushing payments up to the game's maximum limit of **20,000 x**.

Secret Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is basically a game of chance powered by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and a physical wheel, players often adopt particular betting techniques to manage their threat and extend their playtime.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe & Steady Strategy (Number Betting):**
 - Focus primarily on wagering on numbers 1 and 2, while placing little hedge bets on bonus offer rounds. This technique yields frequent, smaller wins and keeps the bankroll steady.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - Place bets solely on the 4 benefit rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-volatility technique created for players who want to experience the minigames as often as possible, accepting that they may experience droughts of non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
 - Cover a mix of numbers and all 4 reward rounds proportionally. This makes sure that almost every spin of the wheel yields some form of return or sets off a feature.

Important Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a set bankroll before visiting and never ever chase losses.
- **Understand RTP:** Keep in mind that various bets have a little various Return to Player portions. Number bets normally offer a greater analytical RTP than benefit bets, but benefit bets use the enjoyment of huge multipliers.
- **Delight in the Show:** Crazy Time is developed as home entertainment first. Treat the prospective winnings as a benefit to the interactive, game-show experience.
