Masonry infill around a resized opening needs to be outlined to preserve the wall rating. Firestopping around overviews that permeate the wall is not a red tube of caulk. Use provided systems. The high-speed doors were not fire rated, however they were located behind the fire obstacle, so we maintained the ranked rolling shutters at the wall surface, readied to shut on alarm system. That three-layer method well balanced flow and safety and security without overburdening any kind of single system.

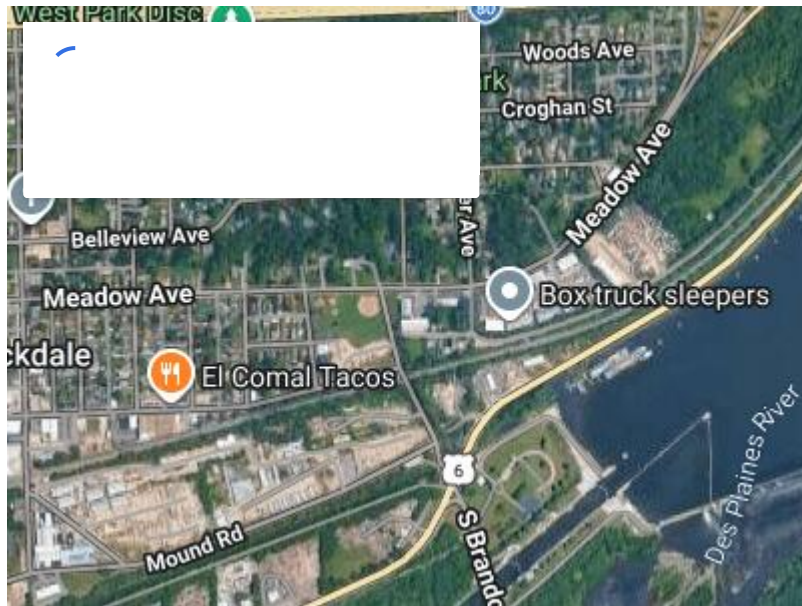
