Popular Strategies for CS: GO Crash

1. The Martingale Strategy

- **How it works:** After every loss, the player doubles their bet. When they ultimately win, the profit covers all previous losses plus an earnings equal to the initial base bet.
- **The Risk:** Requires a huge bankroll. Hitting a long losing streak can quickly exhaust a gamer's funds or hit website wagering limitations.

2. The Anti-Martingale (Paroli) Strategy

- **How it works:** The player doubles their bet after every *win* and resets to the base bet after a loss. This intends to capitalize on winning streaks while reducing direct exposure during cold streaks.
- **The Risk:** A single late loss erases the built up profits of the streak.

3. Low Auto-Cashout Grinding

- **How it works:** Players set an automated cashout at an extremely low multiplier, such as **1.10 x to 1.20 x**, and place bigger bets.
- **The Risk:** While winning portion is high, an instantaneous 1.00 x crash will wipe out numerous wins in a single blow.
