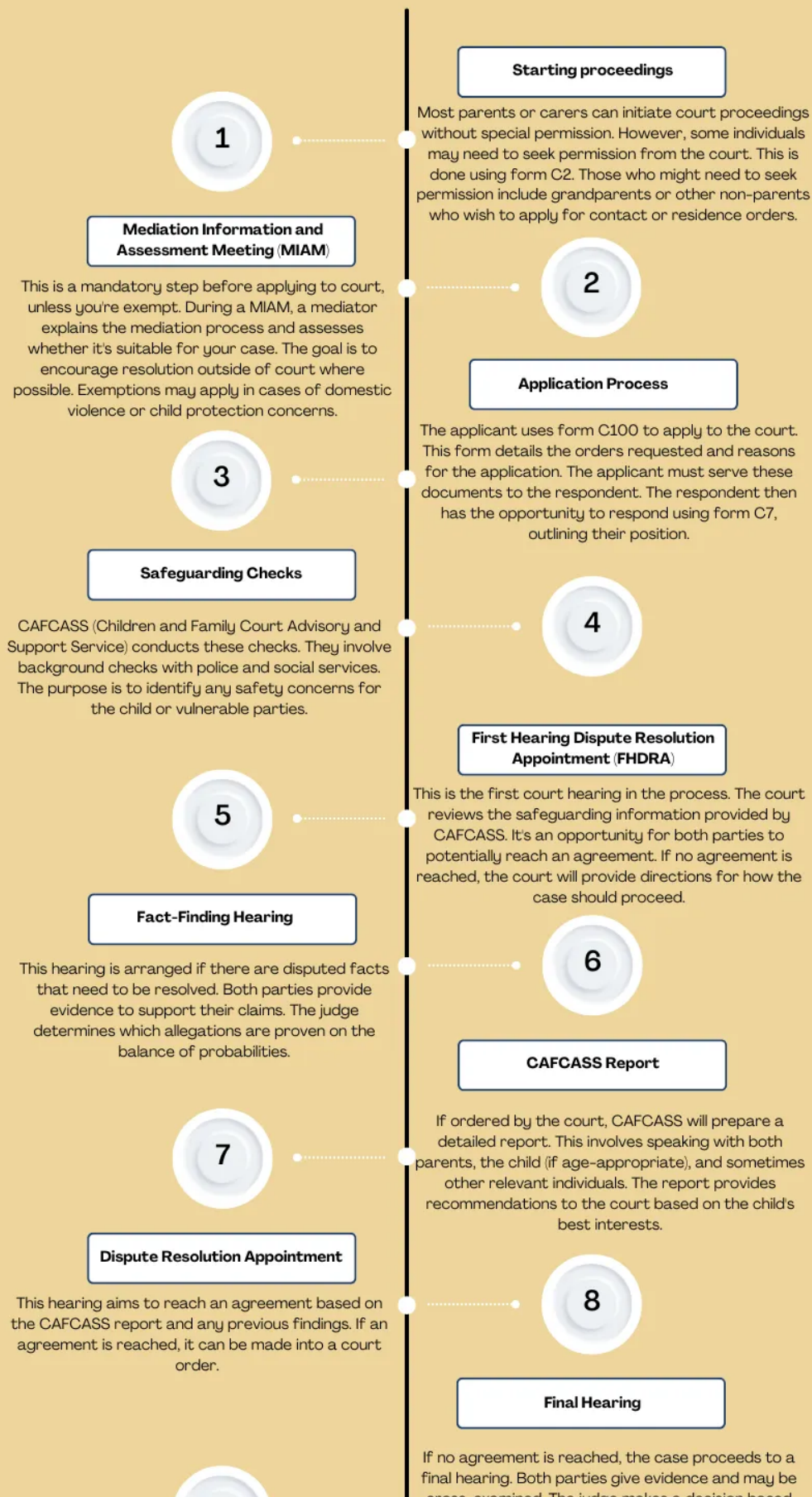
What percent of divorce instances are worked out without a trial?
