

No one recalls which Saturday I realized the big difference among a good-run network cleanup and one who limps along. I just needless to say the smell of moist leaves, a handful of volunteers standing round looking ahead to course, and a roll off dumpster arriving 40 minutes past due to a dead-end street that a 20-foot truck couldn't comfortably exit.
