Clear gain access to for individuals and materials, not simply for you

A lot of preparation is merely "make it easy to reach." Installers require to relocate with your lawn with devices, mix or manage concrete where required, and bring products close sufficient to avoid bring panels over soft yard areas.

Think concerning the course from the gate to the fencing line. If you have side accessibility that's only simply broad enough for a person, that's penalty for strolling, but not always great for relocating long rails, packers, and blog post forms.

In a Melbourne context, one more sensible issue is weather condition. Even if you book installment for a completely dry stretch, ground can still be soft, especially after rainfall. Gain access to that remains usable assists the fencing installer maintain functioning as opposed to stopping briefly for ground and safety reasons.

Make a "clear path" with your mind, not a tape measure

When I claim "clear accessibility," I suggest eliminate anything that produces traffic jams or pressures the installer to step around obstacles. That includes:

- pot plants and freestanding planters near the fence line
- wheelbarrows, tubes, and piled timber
- kids' bikes, trampoline sides, and outdoor furnishings that being in the excavating zone
- ornaments that you might not mind shedding a chip off, yet the fence installer will certainly mind replacing

Protect what matters: yards, pieces, paving, and hoses

- garden bordering that can fracture if the installer steps on it

Plan for the "don't dig here" zones
