Why local knowledge still beats generic promises

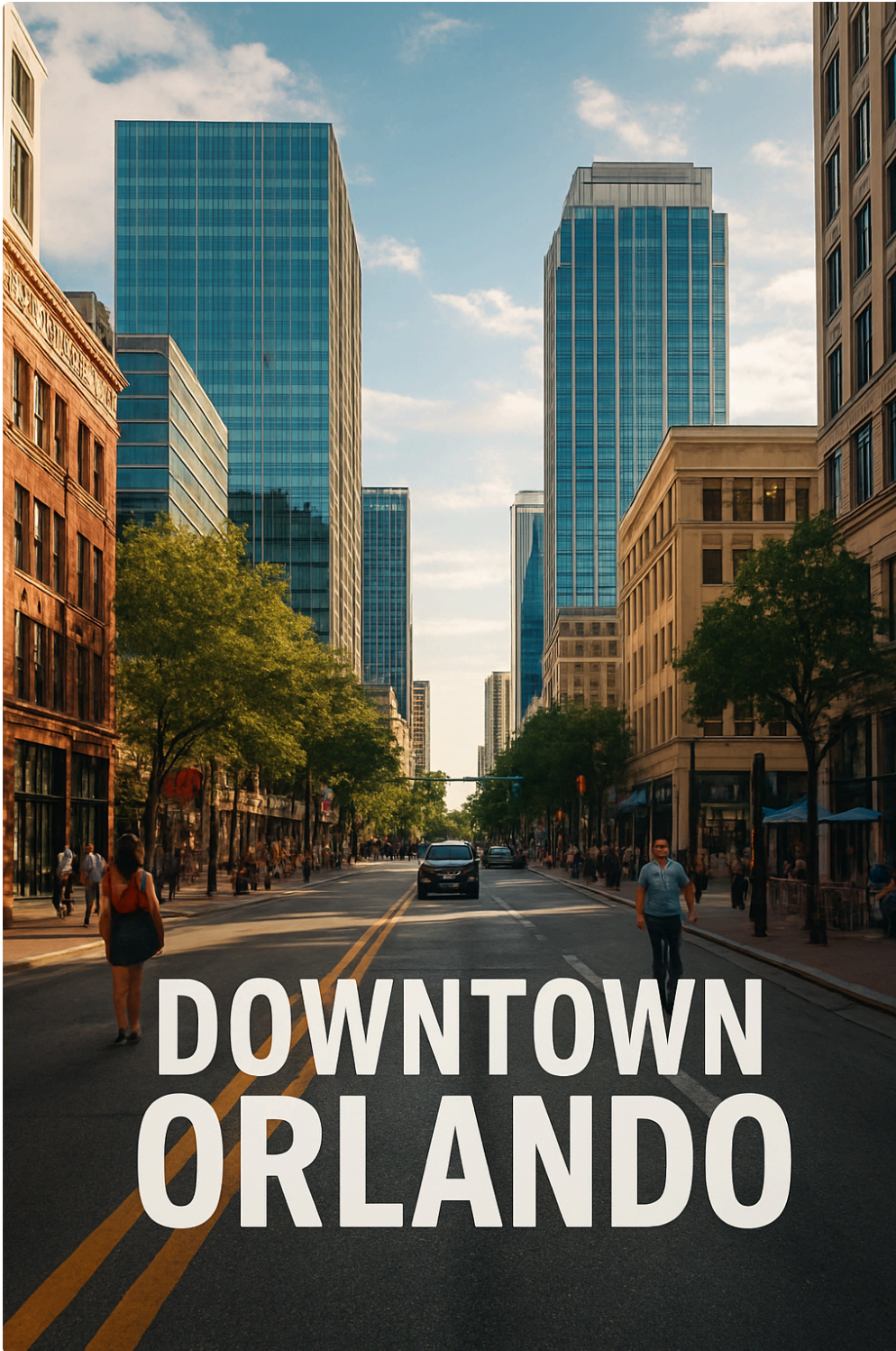
Local service is more than a pin on a map. A locksmith Orlando provider that knows the territory can often waste less of the customer's time.
