On gray, UV-degraded cedar, sanding until eventually you disclose healthful fibers is simple. I want a two-level attitude, 60 to 80 grit to reduce with the aid of oxidized fibers, adopted by means of one hundred to 120 grit to in the reduction of fur. Dust removing subjects. Vacuum, now not just a leaf blower. Where bleeding is likely, including cedar knots or redwood, a stain-blockading primer that truthfully stops tannins is non-negotiable.
