2. The Martingale Strategy (Progression Betting)

- **The Strategy:** Double your bet each time you lose, and return to your base bet when you win.
- **The Goal:** Recover all previous losses with a single win plus an earnings equal to the base bet.
- **The Risk:** This requires a massive bankroll and can quickly strike platform maximum wager limitations or deplete your funds throughout an extended losing streak.

3. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)

- **The Strategy:** Double your bet after every *win*, and return to the base bet after a loss.
- **The Goal:** Ride a hot streak to take full advantage of revenues while decreasing risk during cold streaks.
- **The Risk:** You need to manually cash out at a reasonable multiplier (like 2.00 x) consistently for this to work.
