## 4. Coinflip

A classic 1v1 game of opportunity. Two gamers wager skins of approximately equivalent worth. The system designates one player as Heads and the other as Tails, then turns a virtual coin. The winner takes the whole pot, minus a little platform commission (rake).

## 5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the professional scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match wagering is the go-to alternative. Users wager on expert groups using chances calculated by the platform, similar to traditional sportsbooks.
