- **Remember on Strategy:** Use the demonstration stage to evaluate various wagering designs. Ask yourself: *Do I prefer betting mostly on numbers for consistent, smaller sized returns, or do I want to chase the bonus offer rounds?*
- **Focus on the Top Slot:** Above the primary wheel sits a two-reel slot that spins all at once with every video game round. It assigns a random multiplier to a particular bet area. Notice how typically this multiplier

actually strikes during a live session.
