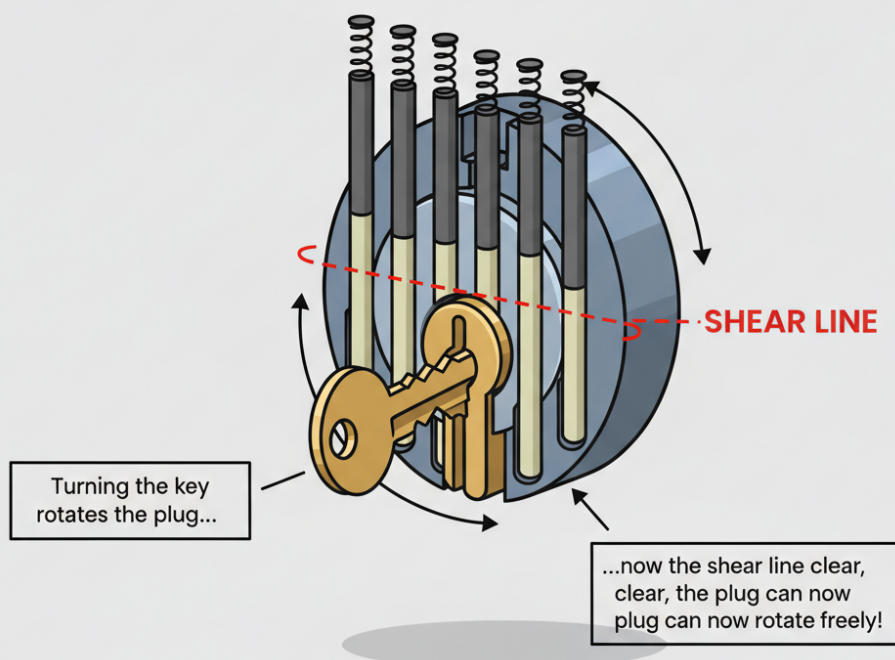
How cost is usually approached
