What is Crazy Time?

At its core, *Crazy Time* is a live dealer game show hosted by an enthusiastic, energetic speaker. The focal point of the game is a massive, vertically mounted wheel consisting of 54 sections. Gamers position bets on the sector they think the wheel will stop on.

While the concept sounds basic, the combination of a **Top Slot**-- a secondary two-reel slots that spins at the same time with the main wheel-- injects random multipliers into every single round. If the Top Slot aligns a bet type with a multiplier, every win associated with that bet is drastically boosted.

The Wheel Breakdown

To understand how the video game works, one must take a look at the layout of the 54 sections. The wheel [crazy time strategies](#) is divided into numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and four reward round segments.

As seen in the table above, the lower numbers appear most regularly, while the lucrative bonus rounds are much rarer, including high-volatility excitement to the gameplay.

The Four Wild and Wonderful Bonus Rounds

The true magic of *Crazy Time* depend on its 4 bonus offer video games. Triggering among these rounds transports gamers from the main studio into immersive, interactive augmented reality mini-games.

1. Coin Flip

This is the most basic and most regular reward round.

- **How it works:** A coin with a red side and a blue side is flipped by a mechanical flipper.
- **The Payout:** Before the flip, random multipliers are assigned to both the red and blue sides. Whichever side lands face up figures out the multiplier used to the player's stake.

2. Cash Hunt

Step up to a huge virtual shooting gallery.



- **How it works:** The screen displays a grid of 108 random multipliers concealed behind different symbols (like a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).
- **The Payout:** Players utilize an on-screen cannon to aim and shoot at one symbol before a countdown timer ends. Once the timer ends, all signs reveal their surprise multipliers, and the gamer wins whatever worth their chosen symbol hidden.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the conventional Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko is everything about gravity and anticipation.

- **How it works:** The dealership drops a puck from the top of a radiant purple Pachinko wall filled with physical pegs. The puck bounces randomly down the board till it lands in one of the landing zones at the bottom.
- **The Payout:** Each zone consists of a multiplier. If the puck lands in a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for huge potential payouts.

4. Crazy Time

The ultimate function of the video game, taking location behind an enormous red door.

- **How it works:** The host opens the door to reveal a surreal, giant virtual wheel with 64 segments and 3 flippers (Green, Blue, and Yellow).
- **The Payout:** The player needs to pick one of the three flippers. The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the picked flipper points to when the wheel stops is granted to the player. Similar to Pachinko, landing on "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" increases all worths on the wheel for a re-spin.

- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:** Placing little wagers exclusively on the four bonus offer sectors (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This method accepts regular losses on base numbers in exchange for direct participation whenever a reward round is activated.
- **Covering the Board:** Some gamers choose to spread out small bets throughout numerous numbers and benefit rounds to guarantee they have a stake in almost every spin. However, this requires cautious bankroll management, as covering a lot of results can rapidly diminish funds if low-paying numbers keep hitting.

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a repaired amount you want to invest before you start playing, and never chase losses.
- **Comprehend the RTP:** Remember that bonus rounds offer high volatility. They can yield huge wins, but they do not hit on every spin.
