### 4. Coinflip

A timeless 1v1 game of chance. 2 gamers wager skins of approximately equivalent value. The system designates one player as Heads and the other as Tails, then turns a virtual coin. The winner takes the whole pot, minus a small platform commission (rake).

### 5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the expert scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match betting is the go-to alternative. Users wager on expert teams using odds computed by the platform, similar to standard sportsbooks.
